PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

On Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August, the NSW Department of Education, in conjunction with the Australian Health Protection Committee and NSW Health, released updated COVID-19 safety guidelines for all NSW Public Schools. While schools continue to be safe places for our students, by following these guidelines we can do our best to keep them that way. The most notable change is in regards to school attendance of students who have or are showing flu-like symptoms.

"In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms.

Schools will make arrangements for students who present as unwell or have flu like symptoms to be sent home.

NSW Health have requested that schools encourage anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, to arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.

Students and staff with flu like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school".


