As a school, we are regularly checking in with each student throughout the day and have incorporated well-being lessons as part of our PD/Health curriculum. It is so important to talk with your children, especially during the many changes that have been happening in all areas of life. Please know, we are always here and don't hesitate to call if you need any advice or direction regarding wellbeing.

GPS is currently operating on Level 3 restrictions. This means:

- Staff will be **required** to wear masks indoors and outdoors while on school grounds
- Masks or face coverings are **recommended** for primary students in indoor and outdoor settings on school grounds.
- We will reduce overall mingling of our classes which means no school assemblies or sport (outside of existing PDHPE classes), excursions or field trips
- Only essential visitors will be allowed on site and will be required to check in and wear masks at all times
- Parents and carers will need to remain outside of school grounds, follow physical distancing and avoid gathering for drop-offs and pick-ups
- There will be enhanced daily cleaning of the school and wherever possible we will ensure classrooms will be well-ventilated with open windows

The school will continue to update parents and community members as restrictions change.

The yarning circle and bike track are almost complete –they both are looking amazing! A big thank you to all involved in getting these projects off the ground and nearing completion.

Thank you for your support of our recent pie drive. We made \$500 which is a tremendous effort.
