Life Ed is committed to safely returning to schools. In the interest of the health and safety of students, teachers and Life Ed staff, and to comply with recent COVID-19 measures, Life Ed has improved the air quality of the Mobile Learning Centres (MLC).

The MLC's have newly installed ventilation inlet vents low to the floors and high-volume extractor fans that run continuously drawing fresh air into the MLC. Life Ed is surveillance testing CO2 levels and doors will be opened safely for short periods during the lesson to allow for cross ventilation and fresh air.
