Welcome back to Term 3! I hope everyone enjoyed the holidays and had a chance to spend quality time together as a family. It has been wonderful to see all our students return to school feeling refreshed and ready for another term of learning, while also sharing with friends and staff the exciting things they each got up to in the holidays.

This term we begin our 2023 Kindergarten transition sessions. Next Monday, 25th July from 3:15pm, we will be holding a parent information afternoon where parents of next year's Kindergarten students can have a tour of our facilities as well as the opportunity to meet staff and listen to a run-down of the many quality programs we have on offer at our school. On Tuesday 26th July from 10:30am - 11:30am, parents will have the opportunity to visit a working Infants classroom to see first-hand how our Infants classroom works. Following these days, we will have three half-day Kindergarten 2023 orientation days (dates are in this newsletter). Please spread the word and encourage those that have children beginning school next year to come and see what GPS has to offer.

On Thursday 28th July, Healthy Harold will be visiting our school. This is a wonderful, interactive program that the children always enjoy. Please pay the \$12 if you have not done so already.

As briefly mentioned at the end of last term, the Cowra Small Schools will be combining to deliver a performance night at the Cowra Services Club on Thursday 8th September, commencing at 6pm. Our students will, this week, begin preparing for this performance with Mrs. Nixon. She has sourced some awesome African drums from the Conservatorium of Music to use too! More information will be shared closer to the date.

In the week commencing 1st August, we will be celebrating Education Week. We will have a book fair set up in the school office during this week, where kids and parents can browse and purchase books, which in-turn provides our school with vouchers we can use to purchase our own books for the school library. We will also have open classrooms and other activities running during this week. A separate note will go home early next week with an outline of what's on. Our next P&C meeting will be on Monday 1st August, commencing at 3:15pm in the Primary classroom. Finally, I would like to remind parents that school starts at 9:15am. Morning supervision of students begins half an hour before school begins. Students should not be dropped off at school before 8:45am. This has been the case since I arrived at GPS in 2020 and has not changed.
