All students were entranced as Aunty Julie shared artefacts and stories to help us understand and deepen our connection to the Wiradjuri people, and to the land. There was a lot of yindyamarra on display, as the kids listened intently, and Aunty Julie was so patient at answering the many questions that kept coming. A big thank you to Mrs. Ingold for organising this visit. Aunty Julie will come back and visit the Primary class over the coming weeks as part of their Geography/History lessons.

We celebrated Harmony Day and Ride Safely to School Day last Friday. Students not only got to wear orange (or something representing their cultural heritage), but they also got to bring/ride their bike/scooter to school. We spent the whole first hour enjoying our amazing bike track with jumps, while the less keen bikers enjoyed sport with Mrs. Chittick. After Fruit Break, we came together again to investigate and celebrate our cultural diversity. We read together, played games and then spent some time sharing our different backgrounds. It was great to hear from so many students and the whole morning was a great example of being proud of your heritage and celebrating diversity.

Our school has been part of The Resilience Project since the beginning of last year. Students engage in weekly lessons on Mondays and Fridays. Our school will be hosting a workshop webinar for parents from 3:15pm on Monday 5th May (Week 2, Term 2). It would be wonderful for as many parents as possible to attend this workshop. For the past almost twelve months, the school has been advocating for the establishment of an OOSH (Out Of School Hours) and preschool opportunity with the Department of Education. 

# Online Parenting Group

#### What is involved?

An online parenting group for parents and carers who would like to:

- Improve communication and strengthen the bond with their child
- Better understand their child's behaviour and learn new parenting approaches
- Connect with other like-minded parents



The group is delivered by experienced facilitators, trained in 2 different parenting programs – Circle of Security and Tuning in to Kids. We usually have a max of 10 parents/carers in a group.

#### When?

Pending numbers, we usually offer a group each school term (beginning Term 2, 2025). Our groups usually occur in the morning (daytime 10am-12noon), with 1 session per week over 7-8 weeks.

#### Not available for a day time group?

Throughout the year, we also try to offer an evening group (e.g. 7:45-9:15pm), with 1 session per week over 6-7 weeks. Please let us know if you would be interested in an evening group.

#### Where?

Groups will take place online via Zoom. Access to stable internet, a computer/device, and a private space will be required.

#### Who is it for?

The group is open to parents/carers of primary or pre-school aged children. We are delivering the parent group as part of our Community Recovery Service which covers the following LGAs in NSW: Cabonne, Cootamundra-Gundagai, Dubbo, Forbes, Gunnedah, Snowy Valleys, Glen Ines Severn, Snowy Monaro
